INCLUDE ACHIEVEMENTS

Including your achievements shows your characteristics and determination. It shows you have ambition and highlights things that you are proud of.



NO MORE THAN TWO PAGES

Don't make your CV any longer than two pages of A4. This will make your CV interesting, readable but not boring.

KEEP YOUR CV UP TO DATE

Updating your CV regularly allows you to be prepared for any job opportunities you may wish to apply for.

MAKE IT READABLE

Ensure that you have a structure that is easy to digest.

WHAT NOT TO INCLUDE:

- Unexplained gaps in employment
- Lying or misleading information
- Spelling, punctuation and grammar errors
- Irrelevant personal information
